- Including ICC, results for March are \$98k positive variance to forecast and \$1.8m positive variance from prior year.



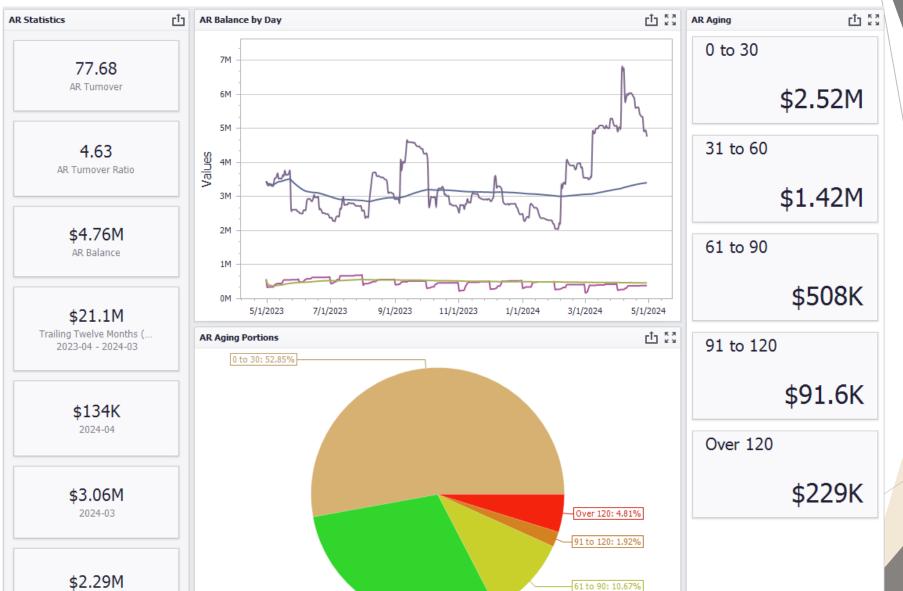

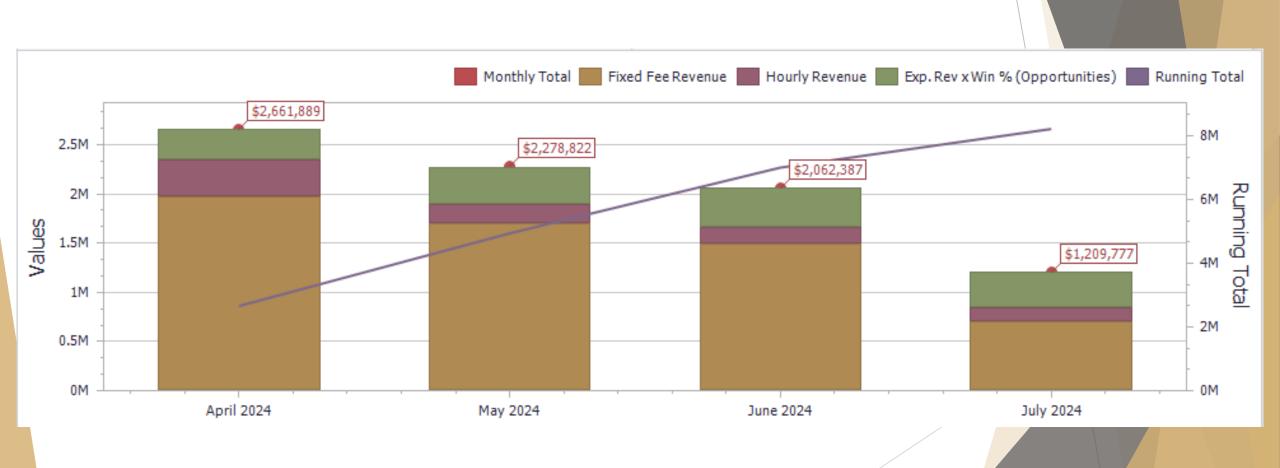

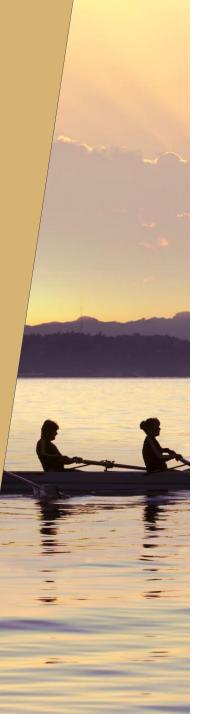

Capture Rate = <u>Total dollars won</u>

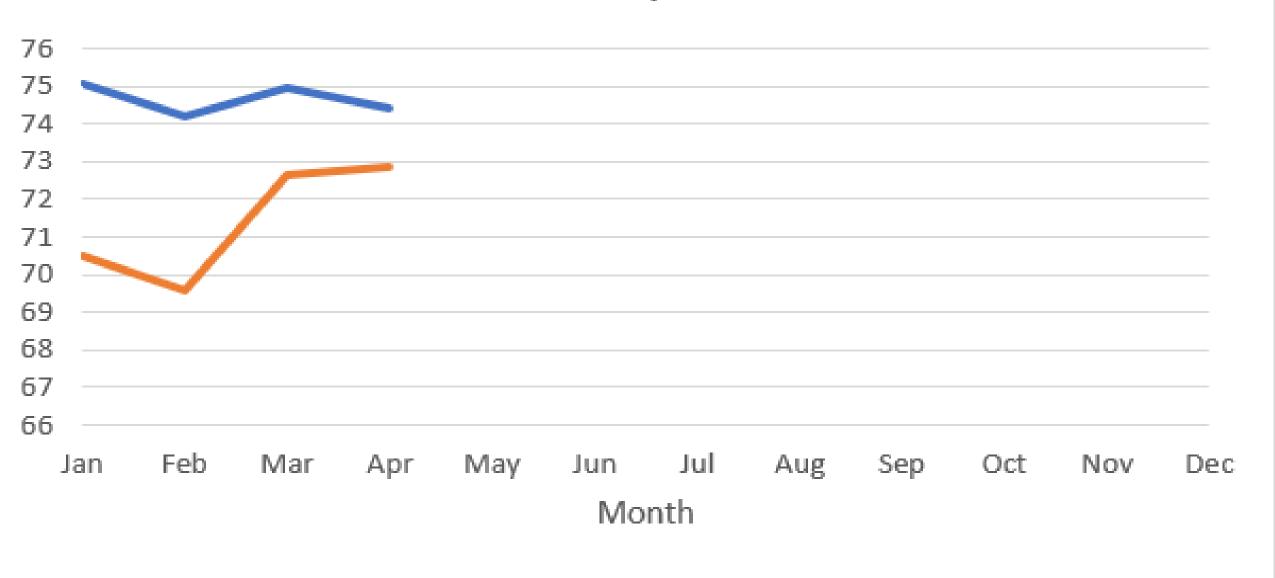
Total dollars pursued

The Capture Rate = \$30M/\$530M = 6%

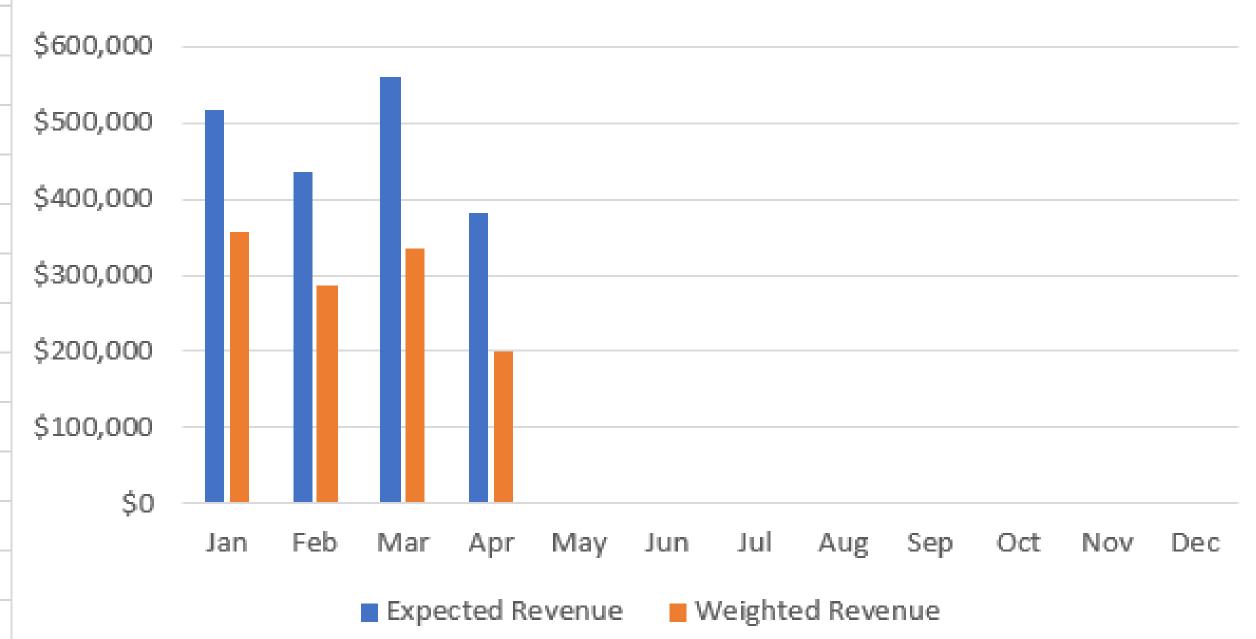

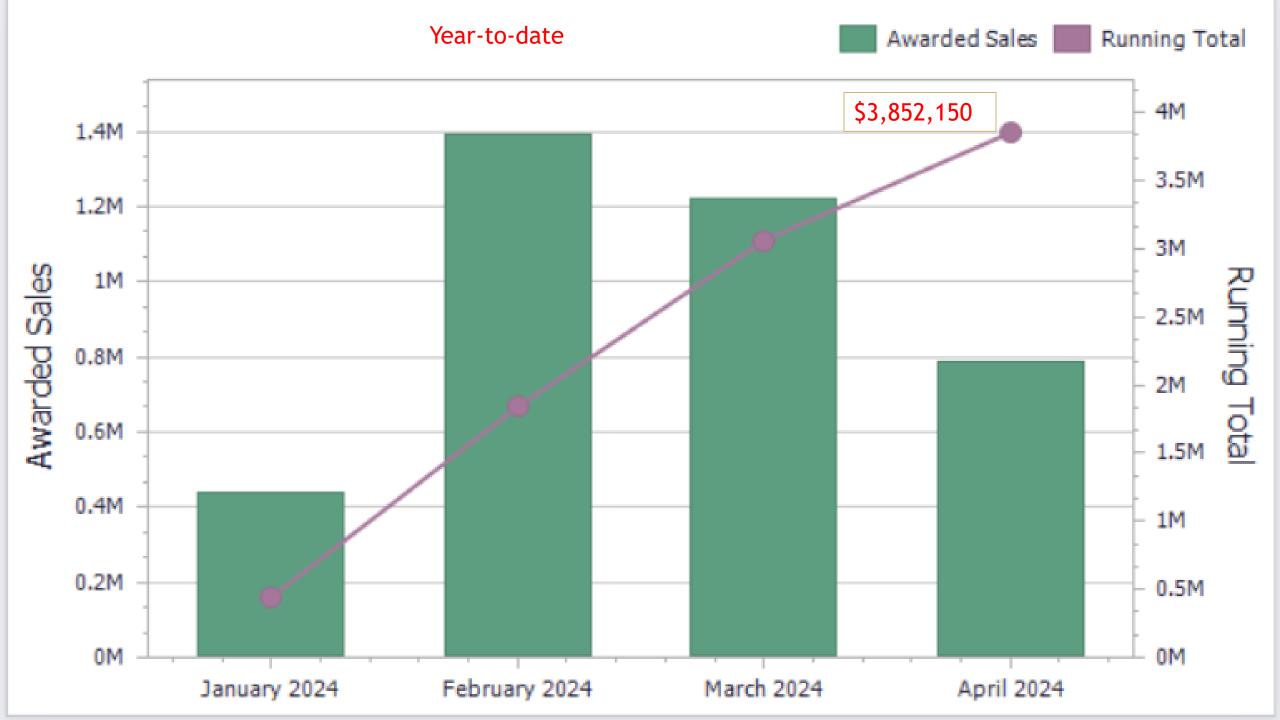


Capture Rate

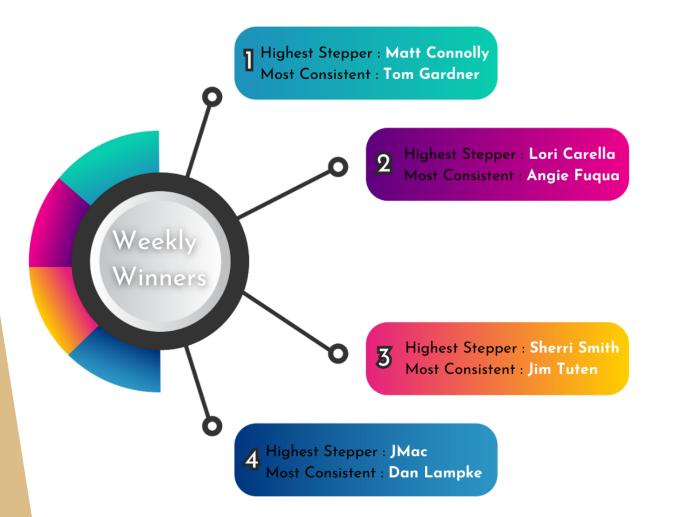
